

THE HARVEY SKIDOO TREE

Q1	Speculate what was going on in both Harvey's and the author's minds before and after their encounter with the tree.
Q2	What would you have done if you were in Harvey's shoes?
Q3	Have you ever been in a situation where you panicked or were 'paralyzed'? If you have, start by giving some background about where it was, why you were there, who was with you, etc before describing what happened. If you haven't describe something similar about what happened to a friend of yours, or make a story up.
Q4	ROLE-PLAY: Imagine that one of you is a person seeking professional help to overcome a tendency to become paralyzed in certain situations such as speaking in public or writing exams and the other(s) is the therapeutic consultant. The client describes the situation and feelings as well as what has been tried in the past in attempt to deal with those situations better. The consultant asks questions to better understand the client and offers helpful suggestions.

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
